ATELIER DE COMPOSITION (COMPOSITION WORKSHOP)

DESCRIPTION

A creative framework in which students gain their first experiences with composition. From the initial idea to the final score, students are guided by the teacher. The tools needed to realize a musical idea are learned through the "learning by doing" method, analysing and listening to works relevant to the student's current project. In this way, students discover the world of musical writing in a creative way.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum age: none

Admission test: **Monday, June 16, 2025, starting at 16h**,
according to a schedule to be determined by the conservatory.

- All candidates must submit a portfolio with several original compositions, allowing the instructor to assess the student's potential and intentions.
- The admission test includes an interview with the course teacher.

Prerequisites for enrolling in this course:

- Having already composed music (written), be curious and passionate about musical writing.

ANALYSE MUSICALE (MUSIC ANALYSIS)

DESCRIPTION

Musical analysis is the discipline of studying a musical work to understand its elements and structure, from melodies and harmonies to rhythms and form. It allows students to interpret the composer's intention and appreciate the work's historical and cultural context. By studying a variety of works, students develop a critical ear and a deep understanding of the different styles and forms of classical music.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum age: none (however, it is recommended to be at least 13 years old)

Admission test: NO

Prerequisites for enrolling in this course:

- It is recommended to have a solid background in musical training to enrol in the “Inférieur” Level Analysis Course.
- Knowledge of harmony is also an asset.
- It is recommended to have, at least, a “2^{ème} cycle” diploma in Harmony to register for the “Degré Moyen” Analysis Course.
- It is recommended to be enrolled, or have obtained, at least a “Division Moyenne” in Harmony to register for the “Degré Supérieur” Analysis Course.

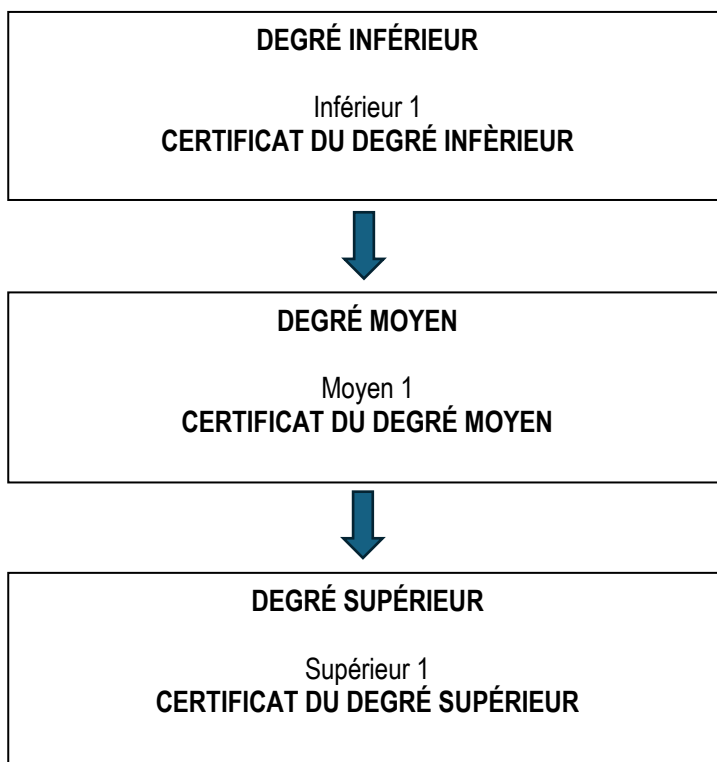

COMPOSITION

DESCRIPTION

The composition course teaches the profession of composer, combining theoretical learning and artistic research.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum age: none

Admission test: YES. If applicable: presentation of a Portfolio with examples of the student's compositions.

Prerequisites for enrolling in this course:

- This course is intended for students with a solid foundation in harmony, counterpoint, analysis, and orchestration. Any student lacking sufficient knowledge in these areas, or not enrolled in these courses, will be systematically rejected.
- Obviously, having previous experience in the field of composition is an asset.

CONTREPOINT (COUNTERPOINT)

DESCRIPTION

Counterpoint is the writing technique that allows the development and control of polyphony, that is, a superposition of melodic lines. In counterpoint, writing focuses on both the horizontal dimension of music, the melodic line, and its vertical dimension, harmony. Students will be guided in this area through practical work based on styles and works from the Baroque and Renaissance periods.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum age: none (however, it is recommended to be at least 12 years old)

Admission test: NON

Prerequisites for enrolling in this course:

- Have successfully completed the Formation Musicale 3 course and/or be registered, at least, for the Formation Musicale 4 course.
- Exceptions, upon study of the candidature, may be considered.

DESCRIPTION

This course aims to establish a transition between the “Formation Musicale” curriculum and the Music Theory courses. Indeed, it offers a first approach to the branches of writing and music history. The introduction of this course, of only a school year, allows to group interests and to promote the "theoretical" branches in order to give them the place they deserve within the musical education. In addition, this course gives students the means to orient themselves in the world of musical expression and the chance to broaden their musical horizons.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum age: 13 years old

Admission test: NO

Prerequisites for enrolling in this course:

have notions of tonality and cadences, and be able to read the treble and bass clefs

Details

- To be admitted to the examination for obtaining the second Cycle Diploma in choral direction, the student must hold the first prize in musical training and hold either the diploma of the middle division, or the first prize of an instrumental or singing branch.

DIRECTION ORCHESTRE (ORCHESTRA CONDUCTING)

DESCRIPTION

Conducting an orchestra requires skills in gesture technique, instrumental knowledge, group management, and knowledge of the world of music. These aspects are covered in this course.

Details

- To be admitted to the first cycle of the Division inférieure of orchestral conducting, the student must follow or have followed the courses of the Division Moyenne or the Division Moyenne spécialisée of Formation Musicale.
- To be admitted to the first cycle diploma examination, the student must hold the second cycle diploma of instrumental training and either the Division Moyenne diploma or the Premier Prix in Formation Musicale.
- To be admitted to the examination for obtaining the second cycle diploma, the student must hold the Premier Prix diploma in Formation Musicale and the third cycle diploma, or the Premier Prix diploma in a branch of instrumental training.
- To be admitted to the Division Moyenne Spécialisée, the student must hold a Premier Prix diploma in a branch of instrumental training and have obtained their second cycle diploma with a final grade greater than or equal to fifty points.

FUGUE

DESCRIPTION

The Fugue course is the natural continuation of the Counterpoint course. Considering the fugue genre to be highly technical and complex, students, guided by the teacher, will learn all its secrets of writing and analysis.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum age: none

Admission test: NO

Prerequisites for enrolling in this course: Be at least registered in the Division Moyenne Spécialisée in counterpoint and harmony.

HARMONIE (HARMONY)

DESCRIPTION

The art of harmony studies the construction of chords, the principles that govern them, and their sequences. Unlike counterpoint, which focuses primarily on the horizontal dimension (melody) of music, harmony focuses more on the vertical aspect.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum age: none (however, it is recommended to be at least 12 years old)

Admission test: NO

Prerequisites for enrolling in this course:

- Have successfully completed the Formation Musicale 4 course and/or be registered, at least, for the Formation Musicale 5 course.
- Exceptions, upon study of the candidature, may be considered.

Lesson organisation: schedule to be fixed together with the teacher

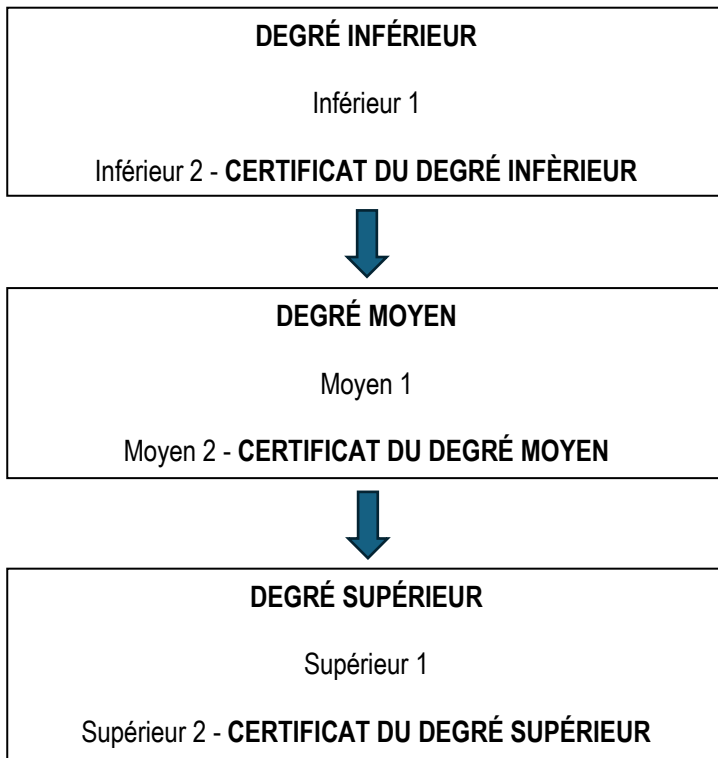
